### APPLICATION FORM

The Bayer HealthCare Pharmaceuticals *Hemophilia Leadership Development Program* is an exciting educational opportunity for a sophomore, junior, or senior year college student(s), touched by hemophilia, who has demonstrated potential and a strong interest in becoming a future leader in the hemophilia community.

This is a paid (\$15 per hour), 8 week internship program (June through August) based at the Bayer facility in Wayne, New Jersey. All related housing and transportation will be provided.

The program is designed to help the intern(s) see firsthand how a product is manufactured and how a pharmaceutical company manages support for the product to the healthcare community treating hemophilia. A robust schedule is planned, including:

- a visit to our manufacturing facility in Berkeley, Calif. to better understand how recombinant factor VIII (rFVIII) is made
- a meeting with healthcare public policy professionals to see how effective advocacy relations impact legislative decisions
- an exploration of marketing and communications strategies
- leadership training classes to develop presentation skills
- hands-on learning about effective project management
- discovering how to listen and influence others
- a personal challenge project to apply new skills to design and create an independent project

1. College sophomore, junior or senior U.S. students who are touched by hemophilia and have demonstrated potential and a strong interest in becoming a future leader in the hemophilia community are encouraged to submit an application.

6. If selected, you will be required to fill out pre-employment documentation and pass a drug screening test.
